RVTS TARGETED RECRUITMENT PILOT

The Remote Vocational Training Scheme (RVTS) assists the recruitment of doctors to targeted rural and remote communities with high medical workforce need, by including the RVTS GP Vocational Training program as a component of the doctor recruitment package. Since 2018, RVTS has successfully assisted the recruitment of 27 doctors to 28 rural and remote locations across Australia, including 11 Aboriginal Medical Services.

RVTS Training is a four-year GP and Rural Generalist training program delivered by Distance Education and Remote Supervision leading to Fellowship of the ACRRM and/or RACGP. RVTS Training is fully funded by the Australian Government.

The Targeted Recruitment model has brought workforce stability and enhanced continuity of care to the participating communities, as well as career progression to specialist qualifications for the recruited doctors. The RVTS Targeted Recruitment strategy is an Australian Government Initiative.



Location



Launceston is 1 hour away and Hobart 3.5 hours away by road. Each offers direct flights to Melbourne, Sydney, Brisbane, Gold Coast, Adelaide and Perth. Hobart offers direct international flights to New Zealand.

Scottsdale is the largest township between Hobart and Launceston with a population of 2000. The high soil quality supports a variety of forestry and agricultural industries including potato and dairy farming, eucalyptus and pine plantations, mining and poppy cultivation since the 1850's.

Scottsdale is a quaint and charming town that overlooks blue mountains and rolling hillsides where poppies, potatoes and forests bloom. The location has a mild climate with warm summers and cool, wet winters.

Ochre Health St Scottsdale holds full AGPAL accreditation, is fully bulk billing and uses Medical Director software. A treatment room offers the opportunity to perform procedures. Pathology collection is offered on-site daily, and x-ray is available 40 minutes away.

The general practice is co-located with the North East Soldiers Memorial Hospital.
