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RVTS TARGETED RECRUITMENT PILOT

The Remote Vocational Training Scheme (RVTS) assists the recruitment of doctors to targeted rural and remote communities with high medical workforce need, by including the RVTS GP Vocational Training program as a component of the doctor recruitment package. Since 2018, RVTS has successfully assisted the recruitment of 29 doctors to 29 rural and remote locations across Australia, including 11 Aboriginal Medical Services.

RVTS Training is a four-year GP and Rural Generalist training program delivered by Distance Education and Remote Supervision leading to Fellowship of the ACRRM and/or RACGP. RVTS Training is fully funded by the Australian Government.

The Targeted Recruitment model has brought workforce stability and enhanced continuity of care to the participating communities, as well as career progression to specialist qualifications for the recruited doctors. The RVTS Targeted Recruitment strategy is an Australian Government Initiative.

Location

St Arnaud is located approximately 300km (3 hours) by road from Melbourne.

The closest regional centres are Bendigo and Swan Hill are 75 and 100 minutes by road respectively from St Arnaud.



Attractions

The town lies within the Grampians region close to the Pyrenees Wineries with beautiful bushland in every direction offering the opportunity for exhilarating bushwalks and exploration Other attractions include the beautiful Queen Mary Gardens, the Railway Hub Gallery, the Wax Gardens, the Silo Art Trail murals adorning town buildings.

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
