RVTS TARGETED RECRUITMENT PILOT

The Remote Vocational Training Scheme (RVTS) assists the recruitment of doctors to targeted rural and remote communities with high medical workforce need, by including the RVTS GP Vocational Training program as a component of the doctor recruitment package. Since 2018, RVTS has successfully assisted the recruitment of 34 doctors to 36 rural and remote locations across Australia, including 11 Aboriginal Medical Services.

RVTS Training is a four-year GP and Rural Generalist training program delivered by Distance Education and Remote Supervision leading to Fellowship of the ACRRM and/or RACGP. RVTS Training is fully funded by the Australian Government.

The Targeted Recruitment model has brought workforce stability and enhanced continuity of care to the participating communities, as well as career progression to specialist qualifications for the recruited doctors. The RVTS Targeted Recruitment strategy is an Australian Government Initiative.



Location

Guyra is located midway between Armidale and Glenn Innes, 30 to 40 minutes away respectively by road.

Sydney is 560km and Brisbane 430km away by road.

Armidale Regional Airport provides direct flights to Sydney and Brisbane.

Guyra is a town situated in the Northern Tablelands in the New England Region of NSW, midway between the capital cities of Sydney and Brisbane. Guyra has a population of 2,000 with principal industries including fine wool and prime lambs, beef cattle, potatoes and tomatoes.

Located at an elevation of 1,330m above sea level Guyra has the distinction of being the highest elevated town in Australia. As a result, the town is known for its cold winters, by Australian standards, with an average of 42 nights below 0 °C each year and some snowfalls. In summer it rarely gets above 30 °C.
