RVTS TARGETED RECRUITMENT PILOT

The Remote Vocational Training Scheme (RVTS) assists the recruitment of doctors to targeted rural and remote communities with high medical workforce need, by including the RVTS GP Vocational Training program as a component of the doctor recruitment package. Since 2018, RVTS has successfully assisted the recruitment of 38 doctors to 41 rural and remote locations across Australia, including 12 Aboriginal Medical Services.

RVTS Training is a four-year GP and Rural Generalist training program delivered by Distance Education and Remote Supervision leading to Fellowship of the ACRRM and/or RACGP. RVTS Training is fully funded by the Australian Government.

The Targeted Recruitment model has brought workforce stability and enhanced continuity of care to the participating communities, as well as career progression to specialist qualifications for the recruited doctors. The RVTS Targeted Recruitment strategy is an Australian Government Initiative.



Location

Triabunna is located on the SE Coast of Tasmania sheltered within Spring Bay at the mouth of MacCleans Creek and Vickerys Rivulet. The town is connected via road to Sorell (eastern shore of Hobart) - 60 km, Hobart - 85 km and Hobart International Airport - 70 km offering flights to major East Coast mainland cities and Auckland NZ.



Attractions

Queenstown is the gateway to the great South-West wilderness area, with popular bushwalks and mountain bike trails.Te Westcoast Wilderness Railway and the Iron Blow Lookout reveal the regions mining past.
The town also plays host to the Unconformity Festival, a

rapidly growing biennial

contemporary arts festival.



Housing

The median house price in Triabunna is \$502.50.

The average house rental price is \$442 per week.



Education

Triabunna has two local schools

Triabunna District School - K-10, and Orford Primary School -K-6.

There are many educational options in Hobart which is 85km or 80 minutes away by road.

Triabunna is a scenic township surrounded by beaches, hills and beautiful tracts of eucalyptus forest. The area contains many historic buildings from Tasmania's colonial period. Triabunna also commands excellent views of Maria Island which can be reached by a short ferry ride from the town.
