RVTS TARGETED RECRUITMENT PILOT

The Remote Vocational Training Scheme (RVTS) assists the recruitment of doctors to targeted rural and remote communities with high medical workforce need, by including the RVTS GP Vocational Training program as a component of the doctor recruitment package. Since 2018, RVTS has successfully assisted the recruitment of 38 doctors to 41 rural and remote locations across Australia, including 12 Aboriginal Medical Services.

RVTS Training is a four-year GP and Rural Generalist training program delivered by Distance Education and Remote Supervision leading to Fellowship of the ACRRM and/or RACGP. RVTS Training is fully funded by the Australian Government.

The Targeted Recruitment model has brought workforce stability and enhanced continuity of care to the participating communities, as well as career progression to specialist qualifications for the recruited doctors. The RVTS Targeted Recruitment strategy is an Australian Government Initiative.



Location

Rochester is a rural town in central Victoria located 180 km north of Melbourne on the Campaspe River between Bendigo (65 km) and the Murray River port of Echuca (28 km).

Rochester is connected to Melbourne via train.



Attractions

The flowing Campaspe River offers great opportunities for fishing and observing the local wildlife. Rochester is well known for its many colorful murals on the grain silos in town depicting native animals and local culture. The town boasts a rich sporting culture with 2 local golf courses.



Housing

Rental property median price is \$450 per week. The average house purchase price is \$423,000. The practice has accommodation options located at the local hospital, 10 minutes walk from the practice.



Education

Rochester Primary School and St Joseph's Primary School offers classes from Prep to Grade 6. Rochester Secondary College offers classes from Year 7 to 12. There is also a variety of schooling options available in Bendigo.
