RVTS TARGETED RECRUITMENT PILOT

The Remote Vocational Training Scheme (RVTS) assists the recruitment of doctors to targeted rural and remote communities with high medical workforce need, by including the RVTS GP Vocational Training program as a component of the doctor recruitment package. Since 2018, RVTS has successfully assisted the recruitment of 43 doctors to 46 rural and remote locations across Australia, including 12 Aboriginal Medical Services.

RVTS Training is a four-year GP and Rural Generalist training program delivered by Distance Education and Remote Supervision leading to Fellowship of the ACRRM and/or RACGP. RVTS Training is fully funded by the Australian Government.

The Targeted Recruitment model has brought workforce stability and enhanced continuity of care to the participating communities, as well as career progression to specialist qualifications for the recruited doctors. The RVTS Targeted Recruitment strategy is an Australian Government Initiative.



Location



Deniliquin is situated on the banks of the Edward River, 290km from Melbourne and 700km by road from Sydney.

The regional centres of Shepparton (136km), Bendigo (170km) and Albury (210km) are easily accessible by road.

Albury airport offers direct flights to Sydney and Brisbane.



Attractions



The Edward River, with its serene waters, has been a source of sustenance, recreation, and inspiration for generations.

Deniliquin is home to the Play on the Plains Festival, held each September / October, which includes the iconic Deni Ute Muster along with many popular music festivals.



Housing



A fully subsidised 3-bedroom house 500m from the town centre and 300m from the Clinic is offered by the Deniliquin Clinic.

The median house price is \$360,000 and the median rental is \$440 per week.



Education



Deniliquin has 4 Primary Schools offering classes Kindergarten to Year 6.

Edward Public School, South Public School, North Public School & St Michaels Catholic Primary School.

Deniliquin High School offers Years 7 to 12.

ABOUT Deniliquin Clinic



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Deniliquin is a rural river town located on the banks of the Edward River a tributary of the Murray River. The town services a productive agricultural district with prominent dairy, rice, wool and timber industries with a population of 6,400. Deniliquin has a cold-semi arid climate with hot, sunny summers and cool, mostly cloudy winters

The skilled doctors at the Deniliquin Clinic offer comprehensive care at the clinic and also at the local hospital and are the main provider of obstetric services, anaesthetic consultations, as well as comprehensive general practice care.

In addition, the Clinic operates two outreach clinics in Mathoura, 20 minutes from Deniliquin, and the Telkuna Clinic at the Aboriginal Lands Council in Deniliquin and the towns two nursing homes.

This position is for a doctor providing general practice services to community, working alongside a group of highly experienced GPs and health professionals. There is the option of participating in VMO work, with admission rights, and participation in the on-call emergency roster to suit.

Referring Hospitals



Deniliquin Hospital and Health Service is located 300m from the clinic with 46 acute beds.

Albury Base Hospital is the closest tertiary hospital located 210km (2.5 hours) by road.
